






## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

**ROAD CLOSURES FROM 5.00AM, RACE START 9.15AM** 

Events of the North are pleased to be working with Worcester City Council to deliver the Sutcliffe & Co Worcester City 10k and Half Marathon in 2025. All races will start and finish on Croft Road with the athlete's village located in the Cattle Market Car Park. We are expecting over 5000 competitors over the two events.



We have worked closely with Worcester City Council to define and approve a road closure programme to minimise disruption to residents and businesses. Wherever possible we will endeavour to make sure that access is made available when it is safe to do so, access for the emergency services will be maintained at all times. We would appreciate your cooperation and understanding during the race.

We would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused and hope you will take to the streets in support of the event showcasing the City of Worcester and cheer on the many runners who have trained so hard for the day.
