

If you decide on a more intimate wedding breakfast in either the Severn or County Suites and would like to finish the day with a large evening reception, the Gheluvelt Suite is available for a room hire charge of £500.00.

Included in the cost of the Civil Service room hire is a floral arrangement for the registry table in colours to complement your theme and the red carpet.

Car Parking

As facilities are limited, car parking is subject to availability and is chargeable. There are a number of spaces that can be reserved in advance to ensure a guaranteed parking place and these are charged at £20.00 per day.

Two guaranteed spaces are included in this package.

Please liaise directly with reception if a guaranteed space is required.

Disabled spaces are located on the immediate left and right as you enter the car park.

All spaces are available from 3.00pm on the day of arrival until 11.00am the following day.

Unfortunately, the hotel does not have facilities for coaches. Guests however can be 'dropped off' or picked up' from the front of the hotel on Foregate Street. A council coach park is located approximately 10 minutes' walk away; please note that charges apply.

As there is only a small car park on site, we should be most grateful if you would encourage your guests to arrange alternative transport

Traditions

If you are looking to follow Wedding Day traditions then the details below will hopefully assist you:

Traditional order for the receiving line;

Bride's Mother, Groom's Father, Groom's Mother, Bride's Father, Bride, Groom, Chief Bridesmaid, Best Man

Traditional order for Top Table;

Chief Bridesmaid, Groom's Father, Bride's Mother, Groom, Bride, Bride's Father, Groom's Mother, Best Man (The seating plan is from left to right)

Traditional order of speeches:

Bride's Father, Groom, Best Man

Something Old, Something New...

This saying dates back to Victorian times and the full version is 'something old, something new, something borrowed, something blue and a silver sixpence in her shoe'

Something Old - represents the link with the Bride's family and the past. A popular choice for Brides is to wear a piece of family jewellery.

Something New - represents good fortune and success in the bride's new life. The wedding dress is often chosen as the new item.

Something Borrowed - is to remind the Bride that friends and family will be there for her when help is needed.

The borrowed object might be something such as a lace handkerchief or an item of jewellery.

Something Blue - symbolises faithfulness and loyalty and dates back to biblical times when blue represented purity. Brides often choose a blue garter to wear. Silver Sixpence in her Shoe is to wish the Bride wealth both financial and happiness
